- **WHY IS THE TILDEN WEST STOCKPILE NEEDED?**

- Tilden needs additional permitted stockpile space to fulfil the current life of mine.
- The west stockpile project has been contemplated for years as part of Tilden's on-going mine planning.
- The west stockpile will be used to store material moved in order to access ore required for Tilden to continue to operate.

- **PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS**

- A wetlands and a stream permit are required for the proposed stockpile area. Based on feedback on initial proposal, Cleveland-Cliffs redesigned the stockpile to significantly reduce wetland, stream and land impacts. The current proposal has:
 - 21.1 less wetland acres impacted – a reduction of over 20%
 - 2088 less lineal feet of streams impacted – a reduction of over 30%
 - 117 less total acres impacted – a reduction of over 25%
- 12,000 linear feet of streams within Escanaba River watershed will be enhanced/restored to mitigate streams impacted by the project.
